Headed North Quilt

60" X 72"

Please read through all instructions before starting this project. A 1/4" seam allowance is used unless otherwise stated. WOF refers to width of fabric. RST refers to right sides together.

Cutting:

From each of your 12 prints cut: (2) 6 1/2" x wof strips
 From these strips subcut: (5) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles

From the background fabric cut: (20) 6 1/2" x wof strips
 From these strips subcut: (120) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares

From your binding fabric cut: (7) 2 1/2" x wof strips

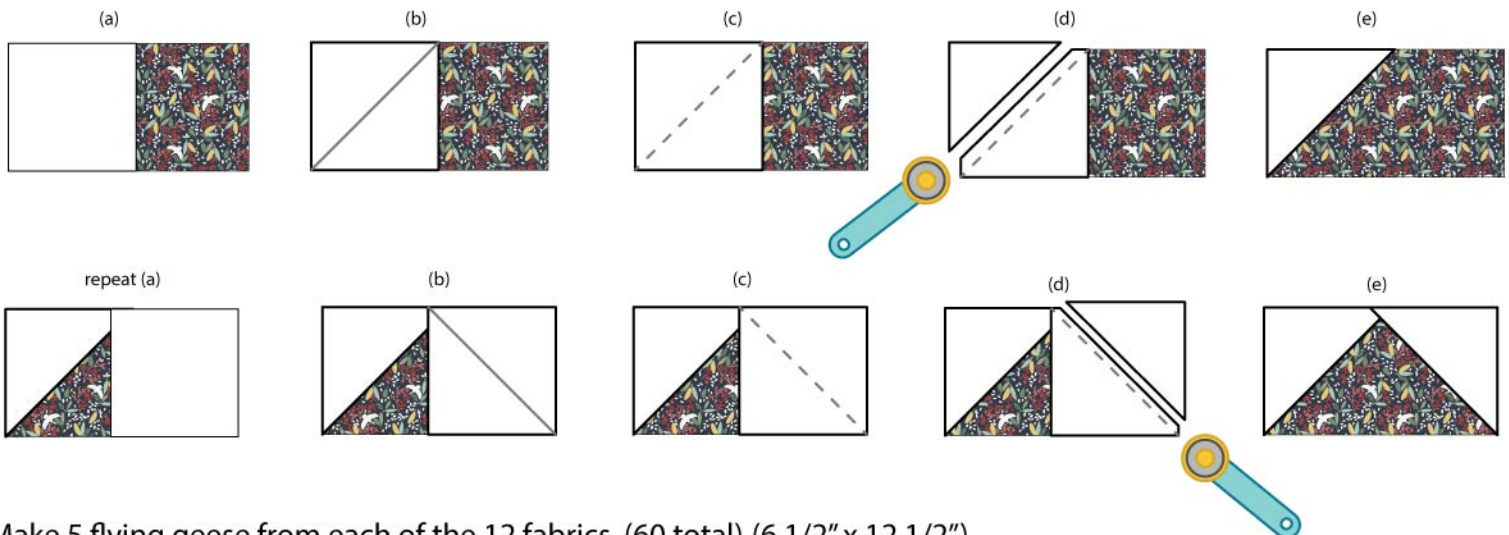
Blocks:

Flying Geese:

Start by placing a 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" white square on the corner of a 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle (rst) (a).

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner with marking pencil (b). Sew on drawn line (c). Trim fabric 1/4" from seam (d) and press outwards (e). Repeat for the other corner.

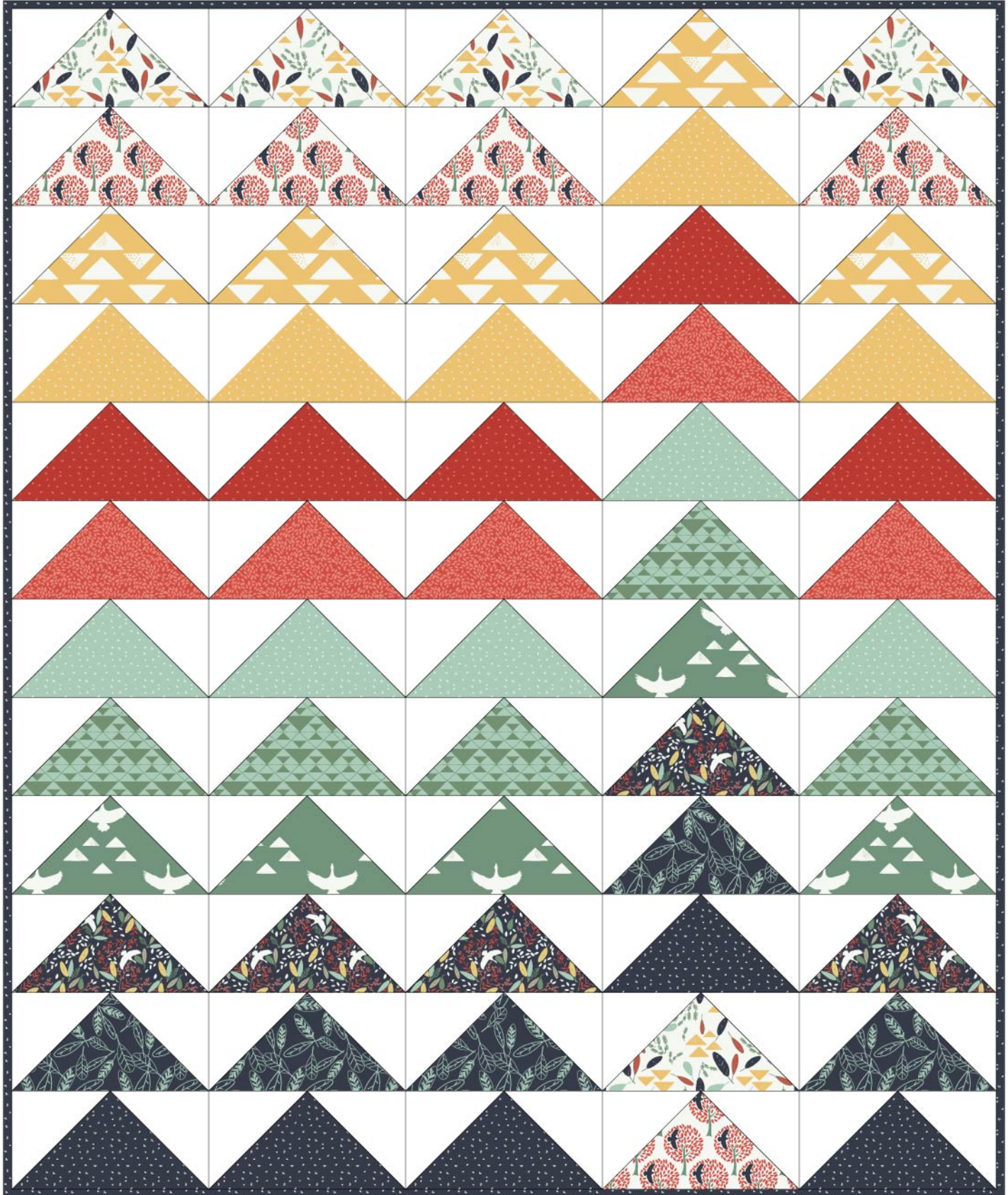
This technique is used for all of your blocks. Refer to diagram below.*



Make 5 flying geese from each of the 12 fabrics. (60 total) (6 1/2" x 12 1/2")

Layout:

Refer to the diagram below to lay out your blocks. Sew the blocks together into rows. Press each row in opposite direction. Then sew your rows together. Super Simple!!



Quilt and bind using your preferred binding method. Enjoy!!
